- 5. **Equipment/Vehicles**: Lt. Savage stated that the vehicles will be delivered on Friday. The sedan is currently on GovDeals. Mr. Wiech asked about the license plate readers. Chief Tucholski stated that the quote just came in at \$14,000.00 per unit. *Mr. Hornung made a motion to approve the purchase of the License Plate Reader, motion seconded by Ms. Arganti. - 6. **General Discussion:** Chief Tucholski stated that the department has been tracking the amount of time spent at the schools regarding the metal detectors. The administrators from the school High school and the Middle school and a janitor assist the kids. Gave a brief overview of how the process is done. The department is working hand and hand with the schools. None of the teachers help. The elementary school is not included in the metal detectors.
