- Personnel: Chief Tucholski stated that Officer Hurless has been training for two weeks and is currently with the Lt. and is coming along nicely. Officer Boxler is finishing up FTO Training and then will be continuing with Officer Hurless. Looking at a candidate for the part-time position.
- 2. **Training**: Lt. Savage is certified in Alice Training. Will be continuing training at the schools and several businesses.
- 3. **Statistics**: Chief Tucholski gave the statistics for the month of December along with the comparison to the prior year. There were 333 calls for service in December and 4,429 in 2019.
- 4. **Crimes**: Chief Tucholski stated that there were some catalytic converters stolen within the village off of vehicles at night. No camera by the locations of the thefts.
- 5. **Equipment/Vehicles:** Chief Tucholski stated that this year the uniforms are in need of replacement. The department uses a couple different locations.
- 6. **General Discussion:** There was an overdose on Pierce Street. Lt. Savage was able to get into the vehicle and was able to extract the passenger and administrating two shots of Narcan into the person. The person survived and was transported to the hospital. The department gets the Narcan for free from a program through the hospital.
