Income tax is down compared to the prior year. Mr. Giardina stated the main 3 revenue accounts as a whole are down a total of 9%, this is mostly due to income tax. Mr. Giardina stated income tax withholdings are lower, business deposits and estimates are lower. Mr. Giardina stated the individual income taxes are still going strong. Mr. Giardina stated total receipts are up but there are big projects in the Village that cause the expenses to be higher than previous years.
