 presentation will be held at Council and the Village will still reach the 2029 goal.
 Mayor Garlich stated they need to make sure they stress the fact that these rates are
 actually being cut back about 60%.

Chief Tucholski stated Mr. Cappello- Village Engineer will be doing a site study on the sewer issues and the downtown pump station not being big enough during a storm surge. Chief Tucholski stated a new water tower will also be needed and the ideal location for that one would be Knox Park and a site study would be needed there as well.
